

Airbus A380 to star in air show

Hyderabad: Airbus A380, the largest aircraft to be manufactured so far, will be the star attraction at the 'India Aviation 2008' air show scheduled to take place at Begumpet airport from October 15 to 18.

Union civil aviation minister Praful Patel reviewed the arrangements for the event here on Wednesday. Speaking to the media later, he said the air show will be held once every two years and that Begumpet airport would be the permanent venue for that.

While it is being held this time in October, from the next time onwards, the air show would be held in the month of February, Patel said. While the defence air shows would be organised in Bangalore, the civil one will

be in Hyderabad, he added.
